GAS TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION

This position reports to the President – NGC, with responsibilities that involve the effective management of the company's natural gas transportation activities through its offshore and onshore facilities by way of:

- Assurance of operational reliability of natural gas supplies to all NGC's customers by creating a safe, reliable and efficient pipeline network for the transmission and distribution of natural gas through safe and efficient operations and maintenance best practices.
- Managing the integrity of the company's offshore and onshore pipeline network.
- Optimisation of gas purchases from suppliers to satisfy NGC's contractual obligations, particularly pertaining to gas quality at delivery from its suppliers and redelivery to its customers.
- Developing a strategy for the operations and maintenance of the Tobago Pipeline Facilities.
- Managing the transportation of gas from other shippers on NGC's 56-inch pipeline from Beachfield to ALNG by way of efficient Operations and effective maintenance best practices.
- Development and implementation of a Feasibility plan for odourisation of the company's gas distribution system.
- Provision of accurate gas and condensate measurements for the timely billing of NGC's customers.
- Provision of strategies for real-time simulations of the existing conditions and future expansions of the pipeline network.
- Development of Capital and Operating Expenditure Budgets; monitor it, implementing strategies for delivering cost control between +/-5% of budget.
- Assurance of delivery of CAPEX projects on budget schedule.

The minimum requirements for the position are:

- 12 years managerial experience with at least five years at a senior level.
