NGC GAS **RUSH** Rules

1. For the duration of the competition, each school participating in the game is allowed **ONE** team of **FOUR** students to represent the school.
2. Any **THREE** members of the team will be allowed to play the game at a time, with the other member as the alternate.
3. Teams may comprise students from Forms 3 or 4.
4. Each team should consist of students who are officially enrolled in the school they are representing.



5. All participating students must be in school uniform.

6. Any member of the team will be allowed to provide responses .
7. Questions will come from the Gas Facts Booklet and any other information provided.
8. Each game will last for 20 minutes .
9. The team with the most points after 20 minutes wins the game.
10. The team which plays first will be determined by random selection in the game system.
11. The first team will select a category and then a point value within that category.
12. For the point value selected, a question will appear.
13. The answer **MUST** be provided in the time allotted or the response will be deemed incorrect.
14. The team to press their buzzer first will be allowed to respond. **ONLY** the first response from the team's representative will be considered by the judges.
15. The team's representative will then have to provide the right response to gain the points.
16. If the representative provides the right answer, the team will receive the point value and will be allowed to select another category and point value within the category (See Rule 10).

17. If the representative provides the wrong answer, the team will lose all the points related to that question, and then the opposing team will be given the chance to respond.

18. If the opposing team's representative responds correctly, the team will receive the entire point value, and will choose the next category and point value.

19. If the opposing team's representative responds incorrectly; the team will lose all the points related to that question; the correct response will be revealed and the team that initially chose will be allowed to choose again.

20. If the response is given after the time allotted to answer has expired, this

will be considered an incorrect response.

21. Only the winning teams will move forward.

22. The judges' decisions are final.
