The operation involves brief periods of gas venting, which may be recognized by the pungent smell of rotten eggs (mercaptan) and hollow sounds. The operation is controlled and would pose no threat to the public.

Residents and businesses in the vicinity of Unilever Trinidad, Eastern Main Road, Champs Fleurs to Bermudez Biscuit Company along the Priority Bus Route and Fletcher Street, Champs Fleurs should be aware of this operation. We apologize in advance for any disturbance caused.
