## Yellow Means Safe, Sound and Underground.

The National Gas Company's (NGC's) natural gas pipelines are buried safely underground and marked in a variety of ways making their locations easy to identify. Just look for yellow marker posts or plates, as well as yellow stenciled markers on roadways.

## FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY, ALWAYS REMEMBER:

- Don't park too close to any of the yellow markers as they must always be visible and accessible in the event repairs become necessary
- Never try to deface or remove yellow posts or plates from their locations; they are labelled with important identifying and emergency information
- Call NGC's Emergency Hot Line 800-4GAS before you dig near a buried pipeline identified by a yellow marker post, plate or stencil
